AUTHORITY

DEFINITION

The law provides for the issuance of special license plates for antique, classic or vintage motor vehicles that are twenty five (25) years or older.

ELIGIBILITY

Any private passenger automobile, van, private truck up to 16,000 lbs, motor home, or motorcycle which is at least twenty-five (25) years old and which has been restored to its original condition without modifications contrary to stock specifications, is eligible for this plate.

REQUIREMENTS

All applications for initial issuance or transfer of an Antique license plate must be accompanied by:

- A current color photograph of the vehicle.
- A notarized affidavit (DPSMV 1911) attesting to the fact that the vehicle has been restored to its original condition without modifications contrary to stock specifications
- OR a photocopy of a card showing applicant's membership in an antique car club.

Note:

- The requirements must also be submitted when the vehicle is sold, if the new owner chooses to retain the plate.
- If the vehicle is not registered in the applicant's name, proper title documentation and fees must be submitted along with the request for the Antique license plate.

FEES

- \$25.00 one-time fee.
- \$8.00 handling fee
- \$3.50 administrative handling fee due only on initial issuance.
- \$3.00 transfer fee if transferring to a new owner

LICENSE PLATES FOR ANTIQUE, CLASSIC OR VINTAGE MOTORS

- \$36.50 \$25.00 one-time fee, \$8.00 handling fee, and \$3.50 administrative handling fee to convert to the special plate.

NOTES:

- This is a lifetime plate with no renewal.
- Credit is not allowed on the \$25.00 one-time fee.
- These plates are available for immediate issuance through the Specialized Vehicle Unit.
- All requests for initial issuance must be mailed to the Office of Motor Vehicles, Specialized Vehicle Unit, P.O. Box 64886, Baton Rouge, LA., 70896. All other transactions can be processed by any motor vehicle office or public tag agent.

PROCEDURE:

- This type plate is issued to a specific vehicle and not to an individual; therefore, the plate cannot be transferred from one vehicle to another. This plate can be transferred to a new owner as lifetime, if the new owner meets the above requirements. A \$3.00 transfer fee is required. The prefix for this type plate is, "AT", i.e., AT1234, for automobiles and trucks and "AM", i.e., AM123, for motorcycles.
- If a customer requests a "title only" from the field office, process the file without issuing a plate and inform the customer that the vehicle cannot be legally driven until the special plate is received from Headquarters, unless a valid temporary tag has been issued for the vehicle. If a customer does not have a valid temporary tag, but wishes to drive the vehicle before the special plate is received, a regular number plate must be purchased.
